Bushell and Meadows, manufacturers of high quality precision engineering products for the medical, aerospace and defence markets, is an inspirational home-grown success story.

The company is based on Tewkesbury Business Park and, after doubling output over the last decade, decided to increase its manufacturing shop floor space by 100% in 2013. The extension was completed in July 2015, allowing them at least another 10 years of space to invest and grow.

Operations Director, Mike Attwood says: "Tewkesbury, as a location, works so well for us because we've got great access to our markets and suppliers. We're looking forward to embracing what the future brings and continuing to grow."

Wimbledon's iconic sliding roof Formula I cars and naval aircraft carriers perform as well as they do today thanks to skills and expertise nurtured in Tewkesbury.

These three remarkable feats of engineering depend on the expertise of Moog - a world leader in design manufacturing and integration of control components and systems. The US-based company, now in its 8th decade, has grown and developed its UK operations in Tewkesbury since 1979 when Moog relocated its facility from Cheltenham to the town's Ashchurch Business Park.

Currently called Plant I, the original building still houses the Aircraft Group business, which delivers cutting-edge technology focusing on stick to tail control systems for both civil and military aircraft.

Basing a courier business at Junction 9 of the M5 was a smart move for Stefan Roberts when he set up RED (Roberts Express Delivery) nine years ago.

Tewkesbury offers easy access to the motorway network and locations throughout the UK and into Europe; a key benefit for the light haulage firm as it has grown and evolved.

Tewkesbury Park is situated on the site of the 1471 Battle of Tewkesbury, with beautiful panoramic views of Tewkesbury Abbey, the Malvern Hills and Gloucestershire countryside.

The dream of its new owners is to make the striking Georgian building, set in 176 acres of mature parkland, a sought-after destination and turn the hotel into a thriving business which makes the local community proud. Facilities include an 18 hole par 73 parkland golf course.

General Manager, Patrick Jones, says: "We've got big ambitions for Tewkesbury Park and we are focusing on putting guest hospitality at the heart of everything we do to further develop this fast-growing business."

Case Studies

For Porsche, a desire to have a presence in Tewkesbury dates back to 2007. The town's location close to customers in the Cotswolds and Cheltenham, made it a very attractive commercial proposition.

The result for the Dick Lovett dealership is a luxuriouslyappointed and striking building which dominates the northwest corner of the roundabout at Junction 9 of the M5.

"There were several key requirements but accessibility was vital and Tewkesbury has great transport links," explains Leon Vitti, Centre Principal at Porsche Tewkesbury. "We've got 2.2 acres here and we don't need it all right now but we wanted to give ourselves room to grow."
